

## DAFA Environmental Compliance Assurance

### REACH compliance

The European Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 concerns the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and restriction of Chemicals (REACH).

The company DAFA is corresponding to the definition of “downstream user” according to the terms and definitions of REACH. Products supplied by DAFA are defined as articles. According to REACH Art. 3 No. 4 articles are not subject to registration under this regulation, only substances must be registered. All suppliers to DAFA are requested to ensure registration of substances used in manufacturing articles for DAFA.

Registered substances, which are identified as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC), are included on the Candidate List issued and revised by ECHA. DAFA is continuously monitoring the Candidate List and will fulfill the obligations to inform of safe use and disposal of articles containing more than 0,1 % by weight of SVHC

The company DAFA has high standards for human health and environmental awareness and declares to comply with the requirements in the REACH Directive.

It is the policy of the company DAFA to fully comply with the REACH legislation and to work closely with suppliers and customers. The compliance is part of DAFA’s policy to keep the customers fully informed of the company’s commitment to the REACH Directive.
